MARCH 1 <i>Exodus 3:1-9</i> God knows the needs of His people. Isn't that comforting?	2 <i>Exodus 3:10-15</i> When our faithful God calls us to service, He will be with us. What has He called you to do? Serve with confidence.	3 <i>Luke 13:1-9</i> Tragedies occur often in life. What can we learn from them?	4 <i>1 Corinthians 10:1-13</i> History doesn't always provide positive examples. What can we learn from the sins of the past?	5 <i>Psalm 38</i> Where do we find relief from sin's misery? In the Lord our Savior.	6 <i>Numbers 16:23-40</i> God protected the office of the priesthood in this graphic way. Be glad all believers are priests in the New Testament!	7 Third Sunday in Lent Praise God for His mercy.
8 <i>Judges 10:6-16</i> How did God lead wayward Israel to repentance? Note how His mercy prevailed. May He forgive our times of unfaithfulness!	9 <i>1 Corinthians 1:18-25</i> How is the Gospel foolishness? How is it wisdom? Thank the Lord He has revealed it to you.	10 <i>Luke 15:1-3, 11-32</i> How are we like the lost son? Give thanks that you know the Father's forgiveness! And watch out for the jealousy of the older son in your heart!	11 <i>James 4:7-10</i> Heed the call to repentance as you come to God in humility. Find cleansing and strength in God.	12 <i>Psalm 32</i> God answers the prayer of the penitent sinner with His forgiveness. Come to Him for relief from the burden of sin.	13 <i>Isaiah 12:1-6</i> Why can the Christian sing to God with such joy?	14 Fourth Sunday in Lent Rejoice in God's forgiveness.
15 <i>Luke 20:9-19</i> Who alone could show the patience of the owner of the vineyard? Review His acts of love. Praise Him!	16 <i>Philippians 3:8-14</i> Follow Paul in his single-minded focus on what truly matters: possessing Christ's righteousness by faith.	17 <i>Isaiah 43:16-24</i> Deliverance from Egypt at the Red Sea was tremendous. What new thing is even greater? Do not take God's grace for granted.	18 <i>Psalm 73:15-22</i> The psalmist began in a dejected mood, envious especially of the wicked. What changed his thinking?	19 <i>Psalm 73:23-28</i> What confidence is ours as we journey through life? What alone gives this confidence?	20 <i>Romans 11:11-21</i> The Gentiles have been grafted into God's family of faith. While thanking God may we also work for the salvation of others.	21 Fifth Sunday in Lent Focus your eyes and your faith on Jesus. He won't let you down.
22 <i>Psalm 24</i> Who is He, this King of glory? We know Him by faith.	23 <i>Philippians 2:5-11</i> Christ's way to glory led through lowliness and suffering.	24 <i>Zechariah 9:9-10</i> Rejoice in your King who brings you peace.	25 <i>Luke 19:28-40</i> Do you see Christ's deity displayed in the preparations for Palm Sunday? Receive Him into your heart with joy.	26 <i>Isaiah 45:22-25</i> All the world will recognize that Jesus is Lord. May we do so in faith and receive His salvation.	27 <i>Hebrews 12:1-3</i> Look to Jesus for salvation. Learn faithfulness from Him and follow in faith.	28 Palm Sunday The lowly King brings salvation.
